FAFSA FREE APPLICATION FOR STUDENT AID WORKSHOP

While federal student aid is available for all Georgia students to apply for aid, According to the National College Access Network (NCAN), “Ninety percent of high school seniors who complete the FAFSA proceed directly to college, versus only 55 percent who don’t complete the FAFSA.” Some choose not to apply because they either think they will not be eligible, or the application process is too difficult.

This session provides small group sessions, in the computer lab, to potentially eligible federal aid students. Students have an opportunity to work through the free application for student aid at a pace that works best for the student and assists in the completion of an accurate application.

Objective: Upon successful completion of this training session, students will have accurately completed the FAFSA application to be considered for federal student financial aid.
